Mrs Catalano welcomed the group.

1. Children read and discussed current layout and information included on Reflection Sheet. Ideas involved making the initial reflection box purpose clearer, to now read: Why have you been asked to complete a reflection sheet? Child's Year group to be included, as well as their name and the date. Children thought this would make it easier to spot any behaviour issues or patterns in year groups.
2. Mrs Catalano has summarized the findings of each of the group's Rights detectives walkabout from last Wednesday. Several gaps in displays were identified:
 - Junior playground Book Nook (Art. 28/29 education)
 - Playground equipment stores (Art. 31 work, relax & play)
 - Junior cloakrooms, Y3 lockers ((Art. 16 privacy)
 - Medical/first aid locker (Art. 24 good health)

Children were each given a laminated Right to go and display in the area they had identified.
