### Minutes

- Mrs Catalano welcomed the group and thanked them for the work they have been doing for the group in their own time.
- Mrs Catalano showed the children photos of the Woodoaks Farm visit. All agreed it had been a very useful visit and had inspired us to speak up about sustainability. The group was proud of the Gazette.
- Group looked at the ideas that were suggested at the last meeting, and discussed how much closer to achieving them we are:
  - Inform all children and families in our school and the wider community about UNCRC and Global Goal 12 – *We have done this through our 2 Gazettes this term and every class assembly so far has mentioned our learning about the UNCRC.*
  - Reach out to our local secondary schools to find out why they are not part of the Rights Respecting programme. Suggest inviting their school councils to visit us. *Year 6 and Year 2 said they would like to prepare an email letter to Rickmansworth School Council. They will be doing this today.*
  - Campaign to the UK government for English schools to become RRS. *Year 3 decided to take this on by beginning with a letter to our local MP, Gagan Mohindra, in which they outline their main concerns and ask what he can do to help address them.*
  - Write to Herts catering to ask about their packaging use policy and/or sustainability credentials. *This has been done and the reply from Herts Catering has been shared on our website.*
  - Y6 are keen that we tell local newspapers about our school and the work of the GG Group. *Year 4 and Year 5 said they would prepare some ideas on this.*
- The next (brief) meeting will be Monday 14<sup>th</sup> November in assembly time. We will consider all work prepared and brought along to the meeting.
