Minutes

- Mrs Catalano welcomed the group and apologised for missing last scheduled meeting.
- Mrs Catalano thanked the group for their contributions to the display in the hall. All the children have seen it and are pleased with the results.
- Year 3 boys presented their draft for a Parent Charter for the school, with a focus on Art.16- Right to privacy, Art.28- Right to an education, Art.31- Right to relax, play and join a range of activities and Art.36- Protection from activities that could harm a child's development.
- Mrs Catalano explained the plans for the group visit to Woodoaks farm next week. Children all expressed their excitement about going.
- The group read a comic style poster explaining Global Goal 12 in child friendly language. We came up with a list of local issues and campaigns that we could get involved in:
 - Inform all children and families in our school and the wider community about UNCRC and Global Goal 12
 - Reach out to our local secondary schools to find out why they are not part of the Rights Respecting programme. Suggest inviting their school councils to visit us.
 - Campaign to the UK government for English schools to become RRS
 - Write to Herts catering to ask about their packaging use policy and/or sustainability credentials
 - Y6 are keen that we tell local newspapers about our school and the work of the GG Group
 - Write to local politicians about the discharges of untreated sewage into the local rivers – as children all love to paddle in the summer.
- The next (brief) meeting will be Monday 17th in assembly time, to prepare some questions in advance of the farm visit.
