### Minutes

Mrs Catalano welcomed the group and asked for updates on fact finding tasks taken on at the last meeting.

- Travel to school questionnaire – Y3 reported that about half the school come by vehicle
- Solar panels- Miss Linch said a survey was undertaken but the roof and school building need significant updating before panels could be considered as there is not enough strength in the building.
- Each collect own plastics from one day and stick to poster to show -this proved to be too tricky as the items won't stick easily to a poster. However, each individual's plastic was rather a lot in just one day!
- Year 6 are preparing an assembly presentation on Global Goals and have liaised with Mrs Muriss about doing this in a Monday morning assembly.
- Rivers Chess and Gade - many of the children asked, paddle in the rivers on a hot day. A discussion about pollution followed and children said they would like to write to someone about it. Mrs Catalano suggested we begin with our local MP
- Research alternatives to Pritt Stick– Children spoke to the office and have concluded that for now, there is no immediately obvious alternative, although all glue stick are expensive.
