## Maths

- \*properties of shapes, drawing shapes accurately
- \*Co-ordinates
- \*SATs preparation
- \*Consolidation and maths projects

At home you can practise multiplication tables, 4 operations ( +, -, x, ÷ ),

## Literacy

- \*grammar revision for SATs
- \*argument texts
- \* Macbeth-settings, character studies, newspaper writing
- \*writing settings and creating a spooky atmosphere
- \*Writing a multi-layered story in the style of Michael Morpurgo

At home you can continue to discuss books and the vocabulary choices

## Science

- \*Animals including humans: looking at the structure of the heart, blood and a healthy lifestyle

At home you can talk about how to keep healthy and discuss their learning and associated scientific vocabulary to build understanding.

## Computing

- \*Coding– Scratch & HTML , physical computing (crumble), leavers video

At home you can encourage independent use of devices and talk to your child about keeping safe online

## Geography

**The United Kingdom** compare the countries of the UK, major cities, physical characteristics of the UK, UK landscapes and people, UK industries and UK energy sources

At home you can discuss places you have visited in the UK-look through any photos you took.

## History

\*Crime and Punishment through the ages leading to their own focus through the ages eg entertainment, medicine

At home you can help your child to research their own topic focus

## RE

- \*Looking at suffering
- \* Holocaust-focus on Kindertransport

At home you can talk to your child about what they have learnt in the lessons

## PE

- \*Dance-world War II
- \*Games: Cricket, Athletics

At home you can dance along and ask your child to teach you the moves!

## Art

\*Sculpture: looking at the painting and sculpture work of Henry Moore and Antony Gormley, copying their techniques to produce figures and a group sculpture

At home you can look at some examples of the artists' work

## D & T

- \*Fairground rides

At home you can look at how gears work and how different machinery works

## French

- \*Le Weekend
- \*Me in the World

\*At home you can work together to tell the time in French-to the nearest 5 minutes

## Music (Mr Tees)

\*composing their own jazz tune, reading and writing notation, learning different notes on their brass instrument, and group marching

At home you can ask them to describe different note lengths and compose their own simple tunes.

## PSHE

At home you can talk about making good relationships, how bodies and attitudes change as children grow up, how to maintain a positive attitude and self-esteem
