Mrs Catalano shared a fact that in a Save the Children survey, only 10% of children think politicians listen to children. The group found this unacceptable and more determined to learn how to make themselves heard. They then spent 15 minutes brainstorming ideas for a name for the group, before finally agreeing on the Y6 suggestion: '**Vital Voices**'. This, they said, reflects the importance of listening to the voices of children in the world. (The alliteration sounds catchy too!)
