Article 3

All adults (Duty Bearers) should do what is best for you (the Rights Holders). When adults make decisions, they should think about how those decisions will affect children.

<p>We will monitor the playground and the games that are being played at all times.</p> <p>We will make sure there are enough adults on duty to prevent any accidents, arguments or unkindness.</p> <p>We will ensure all children are playing safely at all times as well as having fun.</p>	<p>ARTICLE 19</p> <p>You have the right to be protected from harm. You should be kept safe.</p>	<p>We will help others to play safely and choose appropriate games.</p> <p>We will always stay in our Key Stage area at playtimes, unless an adult says we can move.</p> <p>We will be aware of other children playing around us, especially those in younger year groups.</p>
<p>We will encourage children to go outside to make use of their playtime and free time.</p> <p>We will provide a variety of games and activities at lunchtimes and morning break.</p> <p>We will ensure all children are dressed appropriately for the current weather, either in warm coats, trousers and tights or with sun hats, dresses, shorts and sun cream.</p>	<p>ARTICLE 31</p> <p>You have the right to play and to rest</p>	<p>We will go outside at playtime and lunchtime to get lots of fresh air and exercise.</p> <p>We will invite others to join in with games, but also respect their choices of what they want to play.</p> <p>On hot days, we will be sure to drink enough water and rest during long playtimes and lunchtimes.</p> <p>On cold days, we will wear a coat or jumper to keep as warm as possible.</p>
