Maths

Number Multiplication and division (multiplying a one digit number by a two digit number), Addition and subtraction continued, fractions and calculating area and perimeter.

At home you can practise multiplication and division tables. Count in multiples of 4, 8, 10 and 50. You would also do well to count money and familiarise your child with the TIME.

Science

Animals Including Humans We will be looking at the human body and this will incorporate healthy eating.

At home you can look for hidden sugars on the packets of your foods. Can you find different names for sugar?

Geography We will be learning about North America. We will be looking at its physical and human features and where they are located. We will be studying the different countries in North America and comparing London with New York.

Literacy

We will be looking at both non-fiction and fiction texts. The children will be reading and writing fiction (Fantasy and Science Fiction stories, Tale of 2 Robots), recount texts (Escape from Pompeii) which is linked to our Roman topic and Instruction texts. Our Grammar focus will be using subordinating conjunctions, prefixes and adverbs of time.

Computing

Coding, creating pictures, repeating patterns and digital photography

At home you can make sure that your child knows how to spell their surname, as they need that to log into the school system. Encourage independent use of Google Classroom, Word & PowerPoint.

History We will be learning about the Romans. We will look at topics such as everyday life, the Roman army, Romans in Britain and their legacy.
