Maths

Area, Statistics, Properties of Shapes, Position and Direction, Decimals, Negative numbers, Measurement – converting units and volume.

At home you can Find examples of line graphs and charts, decimals and negative numbers in everyday life. Look for shapes around you and discuss their properties. Practise measuring in real life (weight, length and capacity) and convert the measurements. Use positional and directional lan-

Stories from familiar authors, Biographies, Stories from another Culture, Non-chronological reports, Dramatic Conventions (Playscripts), Discussion Texts.

At home you can

Read Jeremy Strong stories, find out about China, read stories from other cultures and play scripts.

Science

Finishing Forces, Living things and their habitats, Animals including Humans (links with PSHE)

At home you can

Look closely at plants and flowers. Think about how animals change.

Computing

Computing : Spreadsheets, coding, physical computing (crumbles)

At home you can : encourage independent use of devices and talk to your children about keeping safe online

Geography

Finishing Mountains, Europe and study of Country/ Region, Volcanoes and Earthquakes, and At home you can Talk about European counties that you may have visited or countries in the news. Research recent volcano eruptions and places where earthquakes have occurred.

History
