Maths

- *properties of shapes, drawing shapes accurately
- *multi-step problems
- *SATs preparation
- *Consolidation and maths projects

At home you can practise multiplication tables, 4 operations (+, -, x, ÷),

Science

- *Animals including humans: looking at the structure of the heart, blood and a healthy lifestyle

At home you can talk about how to keep healthy and discuss their learning and associated scientific vocabulary to build understanding.

Geography

The United Kingdom compare the countries of the UK, major cities, physical characteristics of the UK, UK landscapes and people, UK industries and UK energy sources

At home you can discuss places you have visited in the UK-look through any photos you took.

At home you can continue to discuss books and the vocabulary choices made by the author.

At home you can encourage independent use of devices and talk to your child about keeping safe online

History

*Crime and Punishment through the ages leading to their own focus through the ages eg entertainment, medicine

At home you can help your child to research their own topic focus

PE

- *Games: Cricket, Athletics

At home you can dance along and ask your child to teach you the moves!

D & T

- *Fairground rides

At home you can look at how gears work and how different machinery works

Music (Mr Tees)

*composing their own jazz tune, reading and writing notation, learning different notes on their brass instrument, and group marching
